Question 1 and Question 2: Better Permitting

On July 25th, Shaun announced a [Smart Business Task Force](#) that addressed this issue. We agree it is important to use permit fees and modernized processes to reduce the time it takes to reduce wait times.

Question 3: Adoption of Industry-approved Construction Documents

Shaun's [business credentials](#) have been recognized both nationally and internationally. His career has revolved around modernizing government and government processes. He is more than happy to discuss the adoption of CCDC recommended practices when elected Mayor.

Question 4: Resourcing Important Infrastructure Projects
